FareShare is highly driven by a large network of volunteers, supervised by experienced chefs. FareShare rescues surplus food and cooks free, nutritious meals for people doing it tough. All FareShare meals are designed to be easily reheated, with no need for full cooking facilities, making them ideal for vulnerable people struggling to put food on the table.

### Project scope

To address food insecurity and ensure that people have access to well-prepared, quality meals, Foodbank and Wiley worked collaboratively with FareShare to bring their vision to life—providing 1.25 million meals in its first year of operation.

The new commercial kitchen is the size of a basketball court and equipped with industrial-scale food processing tools, including 300 litre electric saucepans, which cook 750 meals at a time.
